### 3. Présentation du programme de Summer School SUPINFO-HEBUT à Tianjin (in English)

A ten-week program for international students to learn Chinese language and culture, explore the beauty and mystery of China by joining in well-organized cultural tours

The program is intended for international students interested in studying at Hebei University of Technology (SUPINFO-HEBUT) for the summer session which lasts ten weeks. It aims to introduce the students to the Chinese language, culture, society and history. The programs offer courses and tours listed in the curriculum and detailed plan below.



#### 3.1. About Hebei University of Technology

One of SUPINFO's partner universities, Hebei University of Technology (HUT), one of the oldest Chinese universities in China, is located in the City of Tianjin, the third largest city in China, with a population of about 10 million. The city, about 120 kilometers away from Beijing, the capital, can be reached within 80 minutes now by car or 29 minutes by bullet train which runs every 15 minutes in either direction.

Founded in 1903, HUT is a key provincial university as well as one of the national "Project 211" universities in China. The university, with four campuses in Tianjin City proper and two in Langfang City, has an area of 300 acres with a faculty of 2,300 members. The number of full-time students, including master and doctoral candidates, is now 31,000 and is expected to reach 50,000 in five years' time.

The City of Tianjin, near the Bohai Sea, is rich in seafood products that are comparatively cheaper than those in Beijing or elsewhere. In addition, Tianjin is within easy reach of many places of interests and resorts, such as the Beidaihe Sea Resort, Panshan Mountain, Dongling and Dingling imperial tombs.

During your stay at HUT, we would like to provide you with a level of care that we hope will create for you a "Home away from Home"



### 3.2. Curriculum

The summer school will replace the enterprise internship. Students must finish the internship work as explained previously and must be present during the mandatory courses. They must sign a presence sheet during/after each course. Any absence must have reasonable excuses. There will be exams in the end of the summer school.

**At the end of the summer school, Hebei University of Technology will issue each summer school student a certificate.**

### 3.3. Communication with Chinese Students and Teachers

- School visits (visit four campuses of HEBUT, Nankai University and Tianjin University).
- Volleyball, Football, Tennis and Basketball matches with Chinese students and HEBUT's youth faculties.
- International students will have Chinese students as partners.
- Dinner Party (Making Chinese dumplings and western dishes together with Chinese students).
- Graduation Ceremony Party with Chinese students.

### 3.4. Living costs

#### 3.4.1. Accommodation

The accommodation must be paid to HEBUT by students all in one time at the arrival. Students must have the necessary money with them when they arrive in China. It is also possible to make a bank transfer.

We provide you two options:

**International students' dormitory**

**Beixin Foreign Guesthouse.**



In case of double occupancy, you must find your roommate by yourself. If you don't have the roommate, the tariff of single room will be applied.

**3.5. Detailed courses' description**

### 1) *Basic Chinese*

This course is a comprehensive one, which includes reading, speaking and writing. It lasts 10 weeks, offering 60 classroom contact hours of teaching. The students are beginners of Chinese. The course starts with the basics of Pinyin (Chinese pronunciation), strokes of Chinese characters and the basic expressions. After taking the course, the learners should be able to use the Pinyin and grasp the basic skills of writing the strokes.



### 2) *Chinese Speaking and Listening*

The course teaches the students the basics for speaking Chinese and gives them basic listening training. It is for the beginners of Chinese. After taking the course, the students should be able to say and understand basic expressions for daily communication. The course lasts 10 weeks and takes 40 hours.



### 3) *Intercultural Communication*

The aim of this course is to introduce the students to the Chinese culture and its main differences from the western culture. The learners should learn how to communicate effectively in different cultures, especially in the Chinese cultural background. The course lasts 10 weeks, offering 10 hours of teaching. Chinese society and history will be delivered in the form of lectures which will be given occasionally.

### 4) *Taiji Boxing and Chinese Kungfu*

Taiji Boxing and Chinese Kungfu is an important part of the Chinese culture. The course is practice-oriented. The aim is to teach the students the skills of Chinese Taiji and Kungfu, and get them to know the basics of self-defense. It lasts 10 weeks and the lecture will be 2 hours a week.



### 5) *Chinese Cooking*

Chinese Cooking is a part of its culture. The course is practice-oriented. The aim is to teach the students the skills of cooking Chinese food, like how to make dumplings. It lasts 10 weeks and the lecture will be 4 hours every other



week. At the end of the course the students will be asked to cook the dishes they have learned.

**6) Cultural tours**

The aim of the cultural tours is to give the students more ideas of the Chinese way of life and its culture. The tours include the Forbidden City, the Temple of Heaven and other places in Beijing and Tianjin. The tours are organized throughout the summer school.

The tours are optional and organized throughout the summer school.



1) **On-campus dining:**

On each campus there are one or two student dining halls where you can choose whatever you want with a meal card which is available on the first floor of each dining hall (show your student ID). The campuses also have several small restaurants for your convenience.

2) **Academic Exchange Centre (Uni-hotel):**

A restaurant is on the second floor of the hotel.

3) **Others:**

Rice and dishes served in a fast food fashion are available at small restaurants around the local area. A typical box of rice with a side dish costs 5 yuan. You can also enjoy your meals in the restaurants nearby. A typical meal there will cost you around 30 yuan.

**Postal Service**

1) **Pick up letters and packages**

You can pick up your mail daily at the International Office. If you have a package (box, FedEx bulk envelope or registered letter), there will be a slip for you. You need to take the slip along with your HUT ID card to the mailroom at the university's East Campus main gate to pick up your package. However, for some special packages, you have to take the slip and your passport to the post office, located at Dingzigu Erhaolu.

### Security

Always lock your dormitory room. Be sure to secure your valuables. If you go out, keep your money, passport and/or residence permit in a safe place. It is strongly recommended that you not carry your passport while shopping, HUT Student ID will do. Never carry large amounts of cash. Be aware of thieves and pickpockets while on the street.

### Shopping

There are several small supermarkets within a walking distance. Larger ones like Carrefour and Wal-Mart can be reached by bus within 20 minutes. Articles of everyday use and a large variety of food items are available there.

### Shopping Centres:

- ◆ **KaiLaiSai:** Near the North Campus of Hebei University of Technology.
- ◆ **HaiLi edifice:** Opposite BinJiang Road. Take bus #906.
- ◆ **BinJiang Road:** Located in Heping District. There you can buy clothing, shoes and many other things. Take bus #906. Take off at BinJiang Road Stop.
- ◆ **Da Hutong:** All sorts of things are available there. Take bus #5.

### Banking

International Office is ready to help international students to open Chinese bank accounts so that their parents can transfer money into Chinese accounts. Foreign currency in cash or traveler's checks may be converted into Chinese YUAN with the help of the International Office. There is an ATM near the Academic Exchange Centre

(Hotel). There is also a Bank of China across the main gate of South Campus of HUT, providing diverse services. It is recommended that you always go to a big Bank of China, as smaller branches might not deal with foreign currencies.

### **Medical Care**

There is a school clinic near the North Campus. For off-campus medical care, it is recommended that you contact the International Office first. Commonly-used Chinese herbal medicines are available at the International Office and are free of charge. For emergency medical treatment, please dial 120 for Ambulance.

### **Student ID Card**

Upon completion of registration at HUT, you will receive your student ID card. Keep your HUT ID with you at all times in case you are required to show it (such as entering the university campus after 11:00 p.m.). In case of loss, report to the International Office immediately and follow the procedures to get a replacement.

### **Library**

There is a library on the East Campus. If you want to borrow books there, you should obtain a Book Card. Student ID cards are required for this procedure.

### **Transportation**

If you want to go to the downtown area (eg: Binjiang Road or Golden Street), you may take the following buses, No. 5, No. 906, No. 879 or No. 855. Bus fares are 1.5 yuan per person per ride. The most convenient way to travel is by bicycle. Taxis are another inexpensive and convenient form of transportation and this is highly recommended.

### **Weather**

Tianjin belongs to the continental monsoon climate of the North Temperate Zone. Four seasons are distinct, warm to hot and humid in the summer, and cool to cold in winter. It occasionally snows.

### **Hair and Beauty Salon**

Yinzuo Hair and Beauty Salon is recommended and located on Dingzigu Yihaolu, facing the main gate of North Campus.

### **Laundry**

Washing Machines are available in the hotel for international students.

### **Gymnasium and Athletic Field**

LiDu Gym Club: Fifth floor of KaiLaiSai Shopping Centre. (You can do some physical exercise there)

Natatorium: On the South Campus of HUT.

Every campus has an athletic field where students can play basketball, football, Ping-Pong, tennis, volleyball and so on.
